New Testament Reading Matthew 28:18-20 & Acts 1:8

Matthew 28: ¹⁸ Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. ²⁰ Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Characteristics of an Effective Congregation:

The example of the Church in Ephesus – Acts 19-20

A) Established through Evangelism – Acts 19:8-12

Acts 19: Paul entered the synagogue and spoke boldly there for three months, arguing persuasively about the kingdom of God. But some of them became obstinate; they refused to believe and publicly maligned the Way. So Paul left them. He took the disciples with him and had discussions daily in the lecture hall of Tyrannus. This went on for two years, so that all the Jews and Greeks who lived in the province of Asia heard the word of the Lord.

B) Perseveres through Problems – Acts 19:23-31 Acts 19: ²³ About that time there arose a great disturbance about the Way. ²⁴ A silversmith named Demetrius, who made silver shrines of Artemis, brought in a lot of business for the craftsmen there.

... ²⁸ When they heard this, they were furious and began shouting: "Great is Artemis of the Ephesians!" ²⁹ Soon the whole city was in an uproar. The people seized Gaius and Aristarchus, Paul's traveling companions from Macedonia, and all of them rushed into the theater together. ³⁰ Paul wanted to appear before the crowd, but the disciples would not let him.

C) Builds Biblically Grounded Leaders - Acts 20:17 -32

Acts 20: ¹⁷ From Miletus, Paul sent to Ephesus for the elders of the church. ¹⁸ When they arrived, he said to them: "You know how I lived the whole time I was with you, from the first day I came into the province of Asia . . . ²⁸ Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood. ²⁹ I know that after I leave, savage wolves will come in among you and will not spare the flock . . . ³² "Now I commit you to God and to the word of his grace, which can build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified. *See II Timothy 2:2*

D) Constantly Rekindles its First Love – Revelation 2:3-5

Revelation 2: ⁴Yet I hold this against you: You have forsaken the love you had at first. ⁵Consider how far you have fallen! Repent and do the things you did at first.

Do you BELIEVE God can do a new thing in and through our congregation?

Are you willing to BE an active part of this new thing? Let's be open and responsive as we begin a careful study of Paul's letter to the Ephesians.
