Seeking God in 2026

Simeon and Anna are wonderful examples of seeking God (Luke 25-38). Let's follow their example in this New Year!

True Seeking is a Heart of Worship:

Psalm 27: 4 One thing I ask from the Lord, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the Lord and to seek him in his temple.

True Seeking is the Soul's Proper Response to God:

Psalm 63: 1 You, God, are my God, earnestly I seek you; I thirst for you, my whole being longs for you, in a dry and parched land where there is no water.

True Seeking Requires Faith:

Hebrews 11: 6 And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.
