Message from Pastor Russ

Luke 10:38-42 The Living Bible

As Jesus and the disciples continued on their way to Jerusalem they came to a village where a woman named Martha welcomed them into her home. Her sister Mary sat on the floor, listening to Jesus as he talked. But Martha was the jittery type and was worrying over the big dinner she was preparing. She came to Jesus and said, "Sir, doesn't it seem unfair to you that my sister just sits here while I do all the work? Tell her to come and help me."

But the Lord said to her, "Martha, dear friend, you are so upset over all these details! There is really only one thing worth being concerned about. Mary has discovered it—and I won't take it away from her!"

As 2025 draws to a close and 2026 nears, I certainly relate to Martha. I am busy. Yes, at times "jittery" busy. I've got a list of things to do before Christmas. Goals are racing in my mind for 2026.

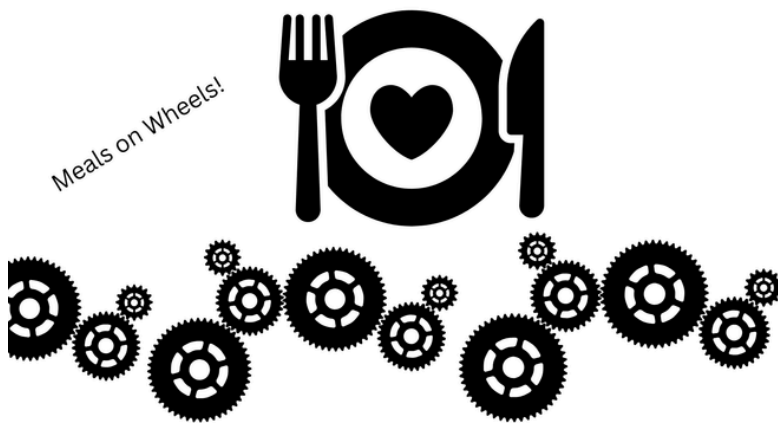
- “Fundamentally prayer is a practice of being present to God, who is always present to us.”
